

WRITE IT, DO IT

Description: Team members describe and build an object

Number of Participants: 2

Competition:

The first team member enters the room and writes a description of a pre-assembled object made of simple items, while the second team member waits outside. After the first team member has finished their description, they leave the room. The second team member enters the room to assemble the object using their team member's description of the object.

The Object:

- The object will be made with paper and various crafting items.
- The baggie of equipment will have more items than needed.

First Team Member:

- The first team member has a maximum of 10 minutes to write a description of the object, while the second team member is waiting in the hall.
- **No drawings or diagrams** are allowed in the description.
- Abbreviations are allowed, including those created by the team.
- No writing that is in the form of a configuration of the layers is permitted.
- After 10 minutes, the first team member who did the writing leaves the room.
- The directions are left for the other team member.

Second Team Member:

- The second team member uses the written description and a baggie of necessary items to construct an object as identical as possible to the original.
- When finished, raise your hand so that the time it took you to complete the building part of the competition can be marked on your score sheet.
- When finished, or time expires, the team's directions and object are turned into the judge.

Scoring: Team with the greatest number of items in the proper location and position wins.

Tie Breaker: Least amount of time to assemble the object.
